Here is what you need to do to become an AYSO referee

Step1 – Fill out a volunteer application in person or online at www.ayso479.com

- 1. Log onto your account or create an account
- 2. Click on the "Volunteer"
- 3. Click "Find Volunteer Roles"
- 4. Select Volunteer name
- 5. Select the current year season
- 6. Select
 - a. "Youth Referee' if the volunteer is under 18 years old
 - b. "Referee" if the volunteer is 18 years old or older.
- 7. Fill out the application and e-sign.



Step 2 – Must take required training courses both online and in person.

- 1. Safe Haven and CCD Concussion training online at www.aysou.org
- 2. Sign onto www.aysou.org with the same login information from www.ayso479.com
- 3. Click "My Courses" to take Safe Haven and CDC Concussion
- 4. Be sure to take a picture of each completion or print them.
 - a. Hint: If you have multiple adults on one account the certificates may have the account holders name on them. Please create a separate account for each volunteer at www.ayso479.com and complete all the training under each individual account to avoid these problems.
